Reason for change:	* The "ref" syntax used for connecting SensorML and SweCommon elements should be replaced. Navigating only on "property" elements or name attributes is error prone and cumbersome. This is especially problematic when writing application schemas extending SensorML. Sticking to the property navigation mechanism results in serious naming issues. Different objects with the same property cannot be used since they aren't accessible. Also, the general OGC policy of reusing established IT technology implies the usage of XPath.
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Summary of change: ⓘ

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It is highly recommended to switch to the well-supported XPath technology. The syntax is safe and much easier to parse. Existing technology can be reused. The syntax and use is much better documented.
