<b>Reason for change:</b>	* The KVP request style allows to specify trimming or slicing using the following syntax: dimension [ , crs ] ( intervalOrPoint )  However the equivalent trimming and slicing constructs in POST do not support the notion of a CRS. Adding to the confusing, there is going to be a separate extension for CRS handling.
<b>Summary of change:</b>	* Have the CRS be handled the same way in both KVP and POST requests.
